I hope you are well. Staff were happy to welcome your children back to school last Thursday. Nga tamariki were excited to catch-up with their friends and to settle back into school routines. This newsletter is a reminder to parents that we are ensuring that safety precautions are in place as advised by the Ministry of Health. At Alert Level 2 there is low risk of community transmission.

Students in Alert Level 2: At Alert Level 2, all children and young people can go to school.

The **only exceptions** are children or young people who are sick or have any COVID-19 symptoms, are in self-isolation, those who have been asked to stay at home by health authorities while awaiting for the result of a test, and those who choose to remain at home because they are at a higher risk of severe illness from COVID-19 and are not fully vaccinated.

Please refer to the last school newsletter to see the Te Kopuru School Safety Plan. We will review this after the announcement this afternoon by the Government in regards to changes to alert levels.
